

Instructions: How to use the Video Tutorials / Subject Folders

The Year 5 subject folders are located above the video tutorials on the website as follows:

1. MATHS INFO
2. ENGLISH INFO
3. VR INFO
4. NVR INFO

Each subject folder above contains the following:

- **A 'Contents' File** (which is downloadable and printable).
This consists of a Contents Page which provides a breakdown of **all** the video tutorials, topics and worksheets available for that subject.
- **An 'Answers' File** (which is downloadable and printable).
This consists of the video tutorial / worksheet answers for that subject.
- **The English Folder contains** a printable copy of the comprehension extract (if needed) and the **Verbal Reasoning folder** contains two printable documents with the 'Pyramid Letters' (more difficult letters in VR) and a printable alphabet (for use with VR tests).
- **Other Information / Files** as needed.

Video Tutorials (Note: number, order and subject of videos may vary to those shown below)

Each week your child will have a total of 8 video tutorials (which include all lessons and homework) set out on the website as shown below, alternating each week as follows:

Maths Tutorial A (L)	Eng. Comprehension (L)	VR Tutorial A (S)	VR Tutorial B (S)
Maths Tutorial B (L)	NVR Timed Tests (M)	Maths Timed Tests (M)	Vocabulary Quiz (S)

Maths Tutorial A (L)	English Writing (L)	Maths Timed Tests (M)	NVR Tech or Puzzle (S)
Maths Tutorial B (L)	VR Timed Tests (L)	Eng./Cloze/NVR (M)	Vocabulary Quiz (S)

The tutorials can be spread out throughout the week so that children do one long lesson (L = 40 to 45 mins) or one medium (M = 25 to 35 mins) and one short (S = 15 to 20 mins) lesson each work session. The Timed Tests in each subject are classed as homework.

The only stipulation is that Maths Tutorial A is done **before** Maths Tutorial B; VR Tutorial A is done before (and in the same session) as VR Tutorial B

The worksheets and tests have been incorporated within the videos. Gwenda will provide the teaching/instructions on these (as well as various instructions for your child on how to record / time their work etc.) as part of the tutorial.

Your child should work in their exercise books, just as they do when they would in class. The scrap book is for VR only (not for maths). All maths calculations should be recorded neatly in their maths exercise book for each maths question.

NOTE: During a mock exam week there will be 4 mock exams (one in each subject) and 4 subject video tutorials (usually all maths or sometimes 3 maths and 1 creative writing).
